Definition Standard normal distribution. The simplest case of a normal distribution is known as the standard normal distribution. This is a special case when $\mu = 0$ and $\sigma = 1$, and it is described by this probability density function: $f(x) = \frac{1}{\sigma\sqrt{2\pi}} e^{-\frac{(x-\mu)^2}{2\sigma^2}}$ –The factor $\frac{1}{\sigma\sqrt{2\pi}}$ in this expression ensures that the total area under the curve $f(x)$ is equal to one. The factor $\frac{1}{\sigma}$ in the exponent ensures that the distribution has unit ...
