Marcus Aurelius wrote the 12 books of the Meditations in Koine Greek as a source for his own guidance and self-improvement.

During his short reign, Carus fought the Germanic tribes and Sarmatians along the Danube frontier with success.. He died while campaigning against the Sassanid Empire, probably of unnatural causes, as he was reportedly struck by lightning.
