But knitting into the stitch below is a little trickier. It's worth mastering, though, because it gives you a cozy, squishy fabric that lots of knitters associate with brioche (which, admittedly, is a bit of an advanced technique).

How to Knit into the Stitch Below. Insert your needle into the stitch directly below the next stitch on the LH needle. Wrap and knit as you normally would. This is the increase stitch. Knit the stitch on the LH needle. You now have two stitches where one used to be. If you look at the purl side of your work,...

How to Knit into the Stitch Below - dummies

Often referred to as the knit one below, this stitch is executed by knitting into a stitch one or more rows below the stitch on the left hand needle. The knit below stitch will safely unravel a stitch to create texture and is the foundation of brioche knitting.

Knit Below - Knit Purl Hunter

To knit into the stitch below, you insert your right needle into the stitch one row below this first stitch, as shown below: When you pull the working yarn through to create a new stitch, it is pulled through one row lower than normal. After the new stitch is completed, there are two strands of yarn around its base.

Both the lower stitch and the loop of the stitch on the left needle come up and around the new stitch. If you were to knit 1 below across a whole row, you would basically unravel it and have a complete mess, but by deliberately selecting certain stitches to knit below, you can develop a lovely sequence of texture.

However, to knit into the stitch below, you must locate the stitch BELOW the blue stitch, which is the green stitch in this diagram. Note that it is going to be easier to knit into the green stitch if you get a good grasp of the fabric and stretch it out, which will open the green stitch so that the right needle can be easily inserted along the red arrow path.

TECHknitting: Knitting into the stitch below

Step 1: Insert your working needle into the stitch directly below the first stitch on your main needle, knit wise. Step 2: Wrap your working needle with the working yarn and knit the stitch as normal, pulling the yarn through the stitch. Step 3: Pull the worked stitch and the stitch above off the needle together. IncR is the abbreviation used for knitting into the stitch below in a way that makes your increase lean to the right. The incRp is a variation where you purl instead of knit. The mirror stitch of this is the incL, the incLp. Abbreviations: How to incR. This increase cannot be made in the first stitch in a row.
